DUAL CREDIT PATHWAY FORM

Students:

To receive credit for a dual credit exam you have taken, you must:

1. Pass the Northeast State Community College (NeSCC) dual credit course exam. Most classes require a score of 70% or better to receive credit for the course. Health-related classes require a score of 84% or better to receive credit for the course.
2. Enroll at NeSCC within **two years** of high school graduation or be dual enrolled at NeSCC while in high school.
3. Send a written request to the High School Programs Office by emailing hsp@northeaststate.edu or complete this form and return to the High School Programs Office via email or mail:

- 2) Dual credit exam scores will be distributed to your high school CTE director.
- 3) Students who want to have their earned dual credit transcribed must follow the steps outlined on this form.
- 4) Dual credit courses are planned processes for advanced placement at NeSCC for technical skills mastered while in high school.
