

Regents Online Degree Program Courses Information

Regents Online Degree Program courses are another option for students to take a class at Northeast State. They are taught by instructors from Tennessee Board of Regents colleges and universities all across the state of Tennessee. You never have to physically attend a class, but you do have to be prepared to take a proctored (in person) mid-term and/or final exam. You do not have to be logged in to your RODP class at any certain time or day of the week. Courses are available for students to work in 24/7. However, RODP courses have assignment/test due dates just like there are in any other class. The only contact that students have with their RODP course instructors is through the RODP class email.

Registration for these courses occurs by using the Northeast State NORSTAR system just like any other Northeast State class. RODP courses are designated in the “class look up” by the “**R50**” section.

ATTENTION: Students taking a section “R50” online class (Regents Online Degree Program – RODP), or *those considering taking an RODP class*. PLEASE READ ON!

To make certain that your RODP learning experience is an enjoyable one, we would like to give you a few instructions on “**What To Do Next**” after you register for an RODP online course.

1. **Go as soon as possible to the RODP website, www.rodpc.org, click on the “Bookstore” link located in the student access box on the right side of the page. Next click on “Textbook and Course Materials” link and follow the steps to order your textbook so that you will have it when class begins. NOTE: THE NORTHEAST STATE BOOKSTORE DOES NOT HAVE RODP TEXTBOOKS AVAILABLE IN STOCK FOR PURCHASE.**
2. Be sure that you have paid your tuition and fees by the due date so that you will not be purged/dropped from your class(es). **You will not receive a bill in the mail. Please note: RODP on-line course fees are non-refundable in refund periods less than 100%.**
3. Fees and tuition for RODP courses are somewhat higher than fees and tuition for Northeast State courses. You will need to check current semester campus literature for the current tuition and fees rates.
4. You should expect to have to come to campus for a proctored mid-term and final exam. Some instructors may choose to let students take their exams online at home.
5. Go to www.rodpc.org/current students and visit: Orientation, Virtual Student Services and Tips for Success.

Do not attempt to log in prior to the first day of classes as given in the semester calendar.

Note: The Northeast State D2L ID and password will not work for RODP Login. It is very important that you login (go to class) for your RODP class the FIRST DAY of class!

6. For log in instructions: go to www.rodpc.org and click on the “Go to Class” link located on the green tool bar on the top of the page. **The log in screen will tell you what to use for your log in ID and password.**
