

ONLINE DATABASES GUIDE

The Library subscribes to over 60 databases that give you online access to books, magazines, and journal articles. All of the following databases are available from any Internet accessible computer, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Start at the Library web page - www.NortheastState.edu/library/.

From off-campus, you will be required to enter your Northeast State user name and password. If you are a community borrower, please contact the Library at 423.354.2429 for the appropriate login information.

Full-Text means that the entire book or article is available for you to read on the computer. Partial Full-Text means that there are some full-text articles and some articles with a citation (only information on where to find the article), abstract or summary (brief information about the article).

eBOOKS

eBooks are full-text books online. To access the eBooks, choose **eBooks – Full-Text Books Online** under *Library Resources* on the Library web page and then choose any of the listed resources.

Gale Virtual Reference Library (GVRL)

Find full-text encyclopedia articles - and graphics when available - from the following multi-volume reference e-books: *Beacham's Guide to the Endangered Species of North America* (1st Edition), *Biology* (1st Edition), *Gale Encyclopedia of Alternative Medicine* (1st Edition), *Gale Encyclopedia of Cancer* (1st Edition), *Gale Encyclopedia of Genetic Disorders* (1st Edition), *Gale Encyclopedia of Medicine* (2nd Edition), *Gale Encyclopedia of Multicultural America* (2nd Edition), *Encyclopedia of Small Business* (2nd Edition), *Gale Encyclopedia of U.S. Economic History*, and *World of Earth Science* (1st Edition).

Knovel Books Online

A collection of over 1,700 full-text books covering twenty-two different technical categories, including: Aerospace & Radar Technology; Biochemistry, Chemistry & Chemical Engineering; Electrical & Power Engineering; Mechanics & Mechanical Engineering; Semiconductors & Electronics, and more.

LearningExpress Library

Interactive online practice tests and tutorial course series designed to help achieve success on academic or licensing tests. Includes practice tests or exercises in categories such as: Math Skills Improvement; Writing Skills Improvement; Technical and Career College Skills; Resume and Interviewing Success Skills; Job Search and Success Skills; GED; Civil Service; Health Careers; Business Writing Skills; Nursing; Real Estate; Military; Graduate School Entrance Exams; and more. The E-Books include study guides and test preparation books.

netLibrary – eBooks

A collection of over 63,000 books representing primarily nonfiction works in literature, business, history, health/medicine, sociology, religion, science, philosophy, computer science, and education, as well as other subject areas. You can access part of **netLibrary – eBooks** through the Library Catalog when searching your topic, but you may want to look at the entire database to see if there are other books available. You must set up an account before "checking out" the book to read online, and you can set the account by following the instructions under *Create a Free Account* at the upper right side of the web page.

Oxford Reference

Search from over 130 dictionary, language reference, and subject reference works with over 919,000 entries, 5,300 illustrations, and 1,400 internet links. In addition, access the full-text of numerous titles from the *Oxford Companion* series. Topics including literature, the arts, humanities, sciences, business, quotations, history, military science, religion and philosophy, and more.

Safari Books Online

A collection of over 200 recently published, full-text books in computer programming and Information Technology (IT), including Cisco, Java, e-Business, Linux/Unix, Macintosh, programming, desktop, web development and administration, Windows, software engineering, .NET, and more.

Testing & Education Reference Center

Provides information on colleges and programs, as well as covers preparatory examinations including entrance exams, certification and licensing tests such as ACT, CLEP, GED, GMAT, GRE, SAT, LSAT, NCLEX, EMT Basic Certification Exam, Civil Service Exams, and more.

To access the databases in order to find articles, select *Find Database Articles* from the Library web page. (*Find Database Articles* is located at the upper right in the blue strip near the top of the Library web page, just underneath one of the pictures.)

Once you have chosen *Find Database Articles*, you will be able to search for a specific database by title, look at the most popular databases that cover a wide assortment of topics, search multiple databases at the same time by using *Agent Multi-Search*, find a specific periodical title by using *Find an e-Journal*, or find articles by subject, which will direct you to appropriate databases to use for specific topics.

With *Agent Multi-Search*, you choose up to ten (10) databases and/or library catalogs to search all at once. You can include the library catalogs of Northeast State and ETSU in order to find books on your topic. Once your search is completed, select the number underlined under *Results* to view the articles and/or books from each source individually. You will see a list of results that match your search and, in most cases, you can revise or change your search within the databases. When you finish looking at one source, close that window by using the *X* in the upper right corner of your screen, then choose another source if you want to examine more search results.

With *Find an e-Journal*, you can search for full-text journals by title or subject area. This resource will tell you which database(s) the title is located in and let you link directly to that title. You can then browse the issue(s) of the selected title. You cannot search for articles by topic here – only browse issues of a specific periodical title. If you want articles, select either a specific database by title, one of the most popular databases, or pick a subject under *Find Articles in Databases by Subject*, then choose a database.

Full descriptions of the databases are available when you choose a subject heading under *Find Articles in Databases by Subject* or choose the first letter of the database's name under *Databases by Title*.

Academic OneFile (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

Comprehensive database with millions of articles from journals and other reference sources. Includes articles on a variety of subjects such as: business and small business, communications and mass media, computers, criminal justice, diversity, education, environmental studies, health and medicine, landscaping and horticulture, military and terrorism, pop culture, psychology, religion and philosophy, and science. Includes the full-text coverage of *The New York Times* from 1995 to present.

America's News Magazines (Full-Text) – coverage varies by title

Search a small collection of twenty-seven popular magazines including *Newsweek*, *Time*, *U.S. News & World Report*, *Fortune*, *Entertainment Weekly*, *Real Simple*, *Sports Illustrated*, *People Weekly*, *Teen People*, *Popular Science*, *Parenting*, *Baby Talk*, *In Style*, and more.

Anatomy.tv (Graphics & Text)

A 3D interactive anatomy and pathology database that allows selection of a particular region of the body to study, such as head & neck, shoulder, spine, thorax & abdomen, pelvis & perineum, hand & forearm, hip, knee, foot, or functional anatomy module. Choose the layer level to view, from skeleton through the surface, including muscles, nerves, arteries, and veins. Click on particular sections and read the accompanying descriptive text, as well as use the zoom, angle, and rotation features to better view the model.

AP Science (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1971 to present

Articles from over 500 titles covering earth, life, physical, medical, and applied sciences. Includes full-page images and diagrams in the areas of biology, chemistry, mathematics, astronomy, geology, air and space, psychology, forestry, botany, environmental studies, engineering, etc.

Applied Science & Technology Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1983 to present

Articles on scientific and technical topics such as aeronautics, applied mathematics, automotive engineering, chemical engineering, electrical and electronic engineering, geology, machinery, nuclear engineering, physics, robotics, textile industry, etc. Includes graphs, charts, diagrams, photographs, and illustrations. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

Art Index and Retrospective (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1929 to present

Article abstracts since 1929 and selected full text since 1997 offer access to an international coverage of art, including advertising, antiques, architecture, crafts, computers in art, interior and industrial design, art history and criticism, fashion design, photography, and more. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

Background Notes – Country Information (Full-Text)

Regularly updated information about the land, people, history, government, political conditions, economy, and foreign relations of independent states and countries, some dependencies, and areas of special sovereignty. Provided by the U.S. Department of State.

Biological & Agricultural Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1983 to present

Articles on biological and agricultural topics such as agricultural chemicals, economics, engineering, and research, animal sciences, biotechnology, botany, ecology, environmental science, fishery sciences, forestry, genetics, microbiology, veterinary medicine, wildlife management, zoology, etc. Includes graphs, charts, diagrams, photographs, and illustrations. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

Business Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1982 to present

Articles on a variety of business topics including: accounting, advertising, building and construction, computers, economics, electronics, finance, health care, international business, publishing, real estate, small business, technology, and more. Access to over 800 publications, including product reviews, biographical sketches, corporate profiles, and reports from associations, societies, conferences and trade shows. Over 450 titles are full text. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

CIA – World Fact Book – Country Information (Full-Text)

Current information about the land, people, geography, government, political conditions, communications, transportation, military, and economy of independent states and countries. Provided by the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency (CIA).

CINAHL (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1982 to present

An authoritative resource for nursing and allied health professionals, students, educators and researchers, CINAHL provides indexes and abstracts for over 1,835 journals. CINAHL provides links to full-text articles in Nursing & Allied Health Collection: Comprehensive.

Chronicle of Higher Education (Full-Text) – coverage from 1969 to present

Information on higher education from articles, news, events, and by topic. Includes job listings, statistical information, advice, and forums, as well as blogs. Also access information specifically on community colleges, technology, faculty, administration, current issues, special reports, and international news.

Classical Music Library (Audio & Full-Text)

A searchable classical music resource that includes tens of thousands of recordings that you can listen to over the Internet. Includes biographies and images of select composers, a glossary of musical terms, and a history of historical music periods from medieval to contemporary.

Computer Database (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

Computer related news, products and reviews on topics such as hardware, software, technology applications, communications, electronics, and engineering. Indexes and abstracts to over 665 titles, and more than half are full-text.

Education Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1983 to present

Articles on education topics including: adult, continuing, distance, preschool, elementary, secondary, higher, special, and vocational education; computers and technology in education; multicultural/ethnic and religious education; parent-teacher relations; school administration; teaching methods; and more. Access to almost 700 journals, with over 400 peer-reviewed and 300 full-text titles. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

ERIC (Education Resources Information Center) (Partial Full-Text)—coverage from 1966 to present

Extensive access to education-related literature including documents, journal articles, selected theses, dissertations and books, and more. Over 1.1 million citations and over 107,000 full-text non-journal documents are available. Sponsored by the Institute of Education Sciences of the U.S. Department of Education.

FirstGov.gov (Full-Text)

Official website of the U.S. Government. Find information by level of government (federal, state, local, or tribal), or by topics such as health, consumer guides, travel, education, defense, environment, history, taxes, etc. The reference center provides data and statistics, forms, graphics and photos, laws and regulations, maps, news, historic documents, and more.

General Business File International (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

Find articles on business and management topics, including company performances, markets, products, industry trends, etc. Access to over 4,100 titles of business journals, investment reports, trade publications and company directories, and over half are full-text.

General OneFile (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

General database that provides information on topics such as business, computers, social sciences, humanities, current events, health, politics, environmental issues, law, the arts, technology and science. Indexes and abstracts to over 10,000 titles from magazines, journals, newswires and newspapers, and more than 5,810 are full-text.

General Reference Center Gold (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

General database that searches magazines, newspapers, and reference books for information on current events, business, industry, arts, science, entertainment, sports, and more. Indexes and abstracts to more than 4,530 titles, including 19 reference materials, and over 3,550 titles are full text. Includes full-text articles from the Christian Science Monitor (1997 to present).

Google Scholar (Partial Full-Text)

General database that searches scholarly literature from peer-reviewed papers, theses, books, and technical reports on a wide variety of topics. Find articles from academic publishers, professional societies, and universities, as well as scholarly articles available on the Internet. Results from the search may include reference to older materials or articles that only appear in books or journals.

Health and Wellness Resource Center (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

Find magazine, journal, and newspaper articles, as well as definitions, directories and hundreds of pamphlets and numerous reference sources on health-related topics. Access to more than 900 health and medical journals (over 670 titles are full-text), almost 300 full-text pamphlets, and 20 reference sources. Includes health-related articles from over 2,200 general interest periodicals and links to health web pages. Now features a Multimedia Library with videos and links to articles on a variety of topics.

Health Reference Center Academic (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

Topics related to general, public, and occupational health and safety, including medicine, nutrition, fitness, diseases, and more. Indexes and abstracts to over 900 health and medical periodicals, and most titles are full-text. Includes health-related articles from over 1,500 general interest periodicals, over 400 full-text pamphlets and 8 reference books.

Health Source: Nursing Academic (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1975 to present

Find articles on a variety of medical topics, with strong coverage of nursing and allied health. The database also includes the *Lexi-PAL Drug Guide*, which has up-to-date and concise drug education sheets covering over 1,300 generic medications and including over 4,700 brand names.

HeritageQuest Online (Full-Text)

A searchable collection of U.S. Federal Census records from 1790 to 1930, over 20,000 genealogy and local history book titles (includes more than 250 primary source documents, 8,000 family histories, and over 12,000 local histories), the Revolutionary War Pension and Bounty Land Warrant Application Files (with over 80,000 Americans who served in the war), the Freedman's Bank Records (registers of African-American depositors), and select House and Senate documents (such as Private Relief Actions, Memorials, and Petitions) from 1789 to 1969.

Humanities Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1984 to present

Articles on archaeology, art, classical studies, communication, dance, film, folklore, gender studies, history, journalism, literature, music, performing arts, philosophy, religion and theology, and more. Access to over 550 titles, with almost 400 peer-reviewed and over 200 full-text titles. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

jInformel (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1987 to present

A Spanish-language database covering current events, business, health, popular culture, and more. Articles from over 152 titles, including full-text articles from 50 popular Spanish language and bilingual magazines. Searching is available in either Spanish or English, and some articles are only in English.

InfoTrac Custom Newspapers (Full-Text)

Includes over 26 million articles from more than 650 newspapers, including U.S., national, regional, local, and some international newspapers. Also includes news and business coverage from an additional 300 sources. Includes selected articles from *The Chattanooga Times-Free Press*, *The Commercial Appeal* (Memphis), and *The Knoxville News-Sentinel*.

InfoTrac Science (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

Includes millions of articles from over 1,600 magazines, journals and reference materials on all aspects of the sciences. Topics include: agriculture, aerospace engineering, architecture, computer-aided design and engineering, electronics, microbiology, physics, plants and animals, psychology, zoology and more. The content of this database is also part of Academic OneFile and General OneFile.

Junior Edition – K12 (Partial Full-Text)

For junior high and middle school students, this database provides access to newspaper, magazine, and reference book articles for information on current events, popular culture, government, history, sports, people, science, and more. Indexes and abstracts to articles from over 215 titles, including 205 full-text titles and 5 reference materials.

Kids Infobits (Full-Text)

Designed for students in kindergarten through grade 5, this database features a visually graphic interface, subject-based topic tree search, and age-appropriate access to full-text newspapers, magazines, and reference books on a variety of topics such as current events, history, people, health, and more. Articles from 182 titles and 14 reference materials.

Legal Periodicals Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1981 to present

Legal information with international coverage and access to scholarly articles, symposia, court decisions, legislation, and more. Topics include: constitutional law, domestic relations, environmental protection, labor law, malpractice suits, occupational health and safety, tax law, etc. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

LexisNexis Academic (Full-Text)

Find general, legal and news information. Includes U.S. and world news, wire service reports, television and radio news broadcasts, transcripts, blogs, business news, and web publications. Also locate U.S. and state laws, court cases, and legal reviews, as well as company information, and biographical information on business, political, legal, national and international figures.

Library Literature & Information Science (Partial Full-Text) – coverage 1984 to present

Find library-related articles on automation, cataloging, censorship, children's literature, circulation procedures, care and restoration of books, preservation, public relations, publishing, and more. Indexes almost 400 titles, many of which are full-text. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

LISTA - (Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts) (No Full-Text) – coverage from 1965 to present

Indexes more than 600 periodicals, many books, research reports and proceedings in the field of Library Science. Subject coverage includes librarianship, classification, cataloging, bibliometrics, online information retrieval, information management and more.

Literature Resource Center (Full-Text)

An integrated resource combining biographies on more than 122,000 authors, almost 3,000 author portraits, almost 5,000 work overviews, plot summaries and explications, more than 415,000 full-text articles and almost 44,000 critical essays, and links to almost 6,000 related Web pages.

Magill's Medical Guide Online

Up-to-date medical and health database includes an A-Z guide with over 1,000 essays, 400 photographs and drawings, and 644 sidebars and tables on issues in the following topics: Anatomy & Physiology; Diagnosis & Testing; Diseases, Disorders, & Symptoms; Mental Health; Prevention & Lifestyle; Social Issues; Specialties and Health Care Providers; and Treatment & Therapy. Indexes, appendixes, and glossary are included.

Military & Intelligence (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

More than 600 military-related and general interest magazines, journals, news sources and reference materials with over 6 million articles covering a variety of topics including military history, aerospace, engineering, ethics, intelligence, law, policy, strategy, terrorism and more. The content in this database is also part of Academic OneFile and General OneFile.

National Newspaper Index (No Full-Text) – coverage from 1977 to present

Indexes only to the *Christian Science Monitor*, *Los Angeles Times*, *New York Times*, *Wall Street Journal*, and *The Washington Post*.

NCJRS (National Criminal Justice Reference Service) Abstracts Database (Partial Full-Text) – covers 1970 to present

Indexes and summaries to over 180,000 criminal justice publications - including books, journal articles, and reports - published by the U. S. Department of Justice; local, state, and Federal government agencies; international organizations; and the private sector. Access is also provided to over 7,000 full-text documents through the NCJRS Virtual Library, which is linked to the database. Provided by the U. S. Department of Justice.

NLM (National Library of Medicine) Gateway (Partial Full-Text)

Information from medical resources, including journal articles, books, consumer health information, meeting abstracts, and more. Provides access to: MEDLINE®/PubMed; TOXLINE Special (toxicology citations); NLM Catalog (catalog information for books, serial titles, and audiovisuals); MedlinePlus (consumer health information); ClinicalTrials.gov (public information about clinical trials); DIRLINE® (directory of health organizations); Genetics Home Reference (consumer information for genetic conditions); meeting abstracts on HIV/AIDS, health services research and space life sciences; HSRP (Health Services Research Projects); OMIM (Online Mendelian Inheritance in Man); and HSDB® (Hazardous Substances Data Bank).

Nursing & Allied Health Collection: Comprehensive (Partial Full-Text)

Articles for nursing and allied health professionals, students, educators and researchers on topics in nursing, biomedicine, health sciences, consumer health and allied health. Full-text for nearly 400 titles. The majority of the full-text titles are indexed in CINAHL.

OmniFile Mega (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1982 to present

General database with information on a variety of topics including education, science, humanities, social sciences, and more. Indexes and abstracts to over 3,800 titles, with over 2,000 full-text titles. Contains all of the indexes, abstracts, and full-text articles from the Business Index, Education Index, Science Index, Humanities Index, Readers' Guide Index, and Social Sciences Index.

Oxford English Dictionary (Full-Text)

A historical dictionary that provides the meaning, origin, and usage of words from all over the English-speaking world. Entries for over 600,000 words provide pronunciation, variant spellings, and the evolution of the word through 2.5 million quotations. Approximately 5,500 new and revised words added annually.

Points of View Reference Center (Full-Text) – coverage from 1900 to present

A database of over 200 topics with an overview, point (argument) and counterpoint (opposing argument), a Guide to Critical Analysis, periodical and newspaper articles, book sections, biographies, primary source documents, images, and video. Topics include: affirmative action, alternative medicine, cloning, gun control, immigration, Iraq, stem cell research, and many more. Also included are guides on debating, developing arguments, evaluating sources, writing papers, and more.

Professional Collection (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

Readers' Guide Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1983 to present

General database with information on topics such as the arts, business, computing, dance, drama, education, entertainment, fiction, film and television, food, health and medicine, history, literature, music, news, politics, religion, science, and more. Indexes and abstracts to almost 400 popular publications, and approximately 200 are full-text. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

Religion & Philosophy (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

More than 250 magazines, journals and news sources with over 800,000 articles covering the topics of religion, philosophy, archaeology and anthropology. Covers the social and cultural impact of religion throughout history, including literature, arts and language. The content of this database is also part of Academic OneFile and General OneFile.

Science Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1984 to present

Articles on science topics such as astronomy, atmospheric science, biology, chemistry, earth science, food and nutrition, genetics, health and medicine, mathematics, physics, physiology, and more. Indexes and abstracts to over 280 titles, with more than 80 full-text. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

SIRS Knowledge Source (Full-Text) – coverage from 1988 to present

Search all of the databases at once or select a specific database to search. Includes articles and graphics on social, scientific, economic, health, historic, business, political, global issues, music, art, film, literature, architecture, performing arts, religion, design, culture, philosophy, current and historic government documents, and information about the federal government, U.S. Justices, U.S. Presidents, and U.S. Supreme Court decisions. Also contains links to and summaries of selected, quality Internet Web pages from the United States and around the world. The pages are continually updated and evaluated.

Social Science Index (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1983 to present

Find articles on social science topics such as anthropology, communications and mass media, corrections, criminal justice, economics, ethics, family and gender studies, geography, international relations, law, political science, psychiatry, psychology, social work, sociology, and more. Indexes and abstracts to over 600 titles, with over 375 peer-reviewed and 200 full-text titles. The content in this database is also part of OmniFile Mega.

Southern Life (Partial Full-Text) – coverage from 1980 to present

Includes almost 6 million full-text articles from academic journals, newspapers and reference materials. Topics are directly related to past and present Southern living and include people, places, historical, cultural and social events, literature, music, food, and more.

Student Edition – K12 (Partial Full-Text)

Designed for high school students, this database provides access to newspapers, magazines, and reference books for information on current events, the arts, science, popular culture, health, people, government, history, sports, and more. Indexes and abstracts to over 560 titles, with almost 500 full-text and 16 reference titles.

Tennessee Newspapers (Full-Text) – coverage varies by title

Provides access to articles in the *Chattanooga Times-Free Press*, *The Commercial Appeal* (Memphis), and the *Knoxville News-Sentinel*.

Theatre in Video (Videos) - 1930s - 1990s

This database contains videos of 279 full-length plays and documentaries and will eventually increase to 350. The 141 plays were recorded while performed before a live theatre audience, and the 138 documentaries cover various aspects of theatre. Additional works will be added to the collection in the future to cover a wide range of twentieth century theatre history. Works by well-known playwrights, directors, actors, and acting companies are represented in Broadway and off-Broadway productions for each decade from the 1930s through the 1990s.
