### Databases:

*Art Index and Retrospective* – Article abstracts since 1929 and selected full-text since 1997 offer access to an international coverage of art, including advertising, antiques, architecture, crafts, computers in art, interior and industrial design, art history and criticism, fashion design, photography, and more. Also part of OmniFile Mega.

*Academic OneFile* – Comprehensive database with millions of articles from journals and other reference sources.

*General OneFile* – A one-stop source for news and periodical articles on a wide range of topics; millions of full-text articles, many with images.

*Humanities Index* – Articles on archaeology, art, classical studies, communication, dance, film, folklore, gender studies, history, journalism, literature, music, performing arts, philosophy, religion and theology, and more.

*General Reference Center Gold* – General database that searches magazines, newspapers, and reference books for information on current events, business, industry, arts, science, entertainment, sports, and more.

*Oxford Reference* – Over 130 language and subject dictionaries and reference books covering topics including literature, arts, humanities, science, business, quotations, etc. Provides access to *Oxford Companions* series.

*SIRS* – Provides access to full-text articles and Internet resources on a variety of subjects such as economics, health, history, business, science, literature, the arts, philosophy, film, etc. An excellent source for government information and U.S. Supreme Court decisions.
