

**ACADEMIC ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE MARTIN
AND
NORTHEAST STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

University of Tennessee Martin and Northeast State Community College recognize the need and importance of facilitating the transfer of students from one institution to the other as they pursue their Bachelor of Science Business Administration – Management goals. Therefore, University of Tennessee Martin (UTM) and Northeast State Community College (NeSCC) enter into this agreement for the purpose of articulating policies and procedures governing the matriculation of Northeast State Community College graduates at the University of Tennessee Martin.

1. Holders of the Associate of Sciences Degrees

- 1.1 Students who have been certified as earning the associate of science with a Bachelor of Science Business Administration emphasis from Northeast State Community College based upon a baccalaureate-oriented sequence of courses are guaranteed admission to University of Tennessee Martin. Students who have completed a minimum of 12 college-level quarter/semester hours prior to enrollment at the University of Tennessee Martin must have a 2.00 grade point average to be admitted to the university.
- 1.2 These students will be classified as juniors.
- 1.3 These students will have satisfied all lower division general education core requirements of the modified core for Bachelor of Science Business Administration at University of Tennessee Martin. (See attached curriculum guide.)
- 1.4 Students must meet all other graduation requirements of University of Tennessee Martin, both general graduation requirements and those particular to the management major. This includes minimum semester hour and grade point average requirements, upper division credit requirement, and the residency requirement, and minimum credits earned at an accredited four-year institution as stipulated in the University of Tennessee Martin catalog.

2. Transfer Credits

- 2.1 Transfer students from Northeast State Community College who have taken a baccalaureate-oriented course of study, but have not completed an associate degree, or who have pursued the associate of applied science curriculum will receive credit on a course-by-course basis. Any course with a grade of C or better will be evaluated for credit.

3. Admission to University of Tennessee Martin's Bachelor of Science Business Administration Program

3.1 Admission to University of Tennessee Martin does not necessarily guarantee admission to the Bachelor of Science Business Administration Program. The requirements for admission to the University of Tennessee Martin Bachelor of Science in Business Administration - Management program are outlined in the University of Tennessee Martin Catalog. Students should be familiar with the specific requirements of the Management major.

4. Financial Aid

4.1 Students admitted to University of Tennessee Martin from Northeast State Community College may be eligible for merit scholarships based upon academic performance, as well as other forms of financial aid.

4.2 All Northeast State Community College graduates who transfer as full-time students to University of Tennessee Martin are eligible for financial aid on the same basis as any University of Tennessee Martin students.

5. Responsibility of University of Tennessee Martin

During the period of this agreement, University of Tennessee Martin agrees to:

5.1 publish annually a transfer equivalency table (developed by the University of Tennessee Martin Registrar's Office) for Northeast State Community College students to use in planning their program of study.

6. Responsibility of Northeast State Community College

During the period of this agreement, Northeast State Community College agrees to:

6.1 publicize this agreement to its students, faculty and administration;

6.2 provide Northeast State Community College students and prospective students a description of the recommended Bachelor of Science in Business Administration – Management curriculum; and,

6.3 review the performance of Northeast State Community College graduates who matriculate at University of Tennessee Martin, assessing the students' academic preparation and the success of the general Bachelor of Science Business Administration courses.

7. Institutional Cooperation


During the period of this agreement, both institutions agree to:

7.1 arrange articulation meetings to consider appropriate major course equivalencies between University of Tennessee Martin and Northeast State Community College. Northeast State's vice president of Academic Affairs and the University of Tennessee's Program Manager at the Kingsport Center for Higher Education will arrange annual articulation meetings with the University of Tennessee Martin's Dean of Business and Global Affairs to discuss topics including, but not limited to, curricular changes, student success initiatives, and other transfer topics as requested.


8 Dissolution of Agreement

8.1 The above provisions are agreed to and shall go into effect when signed by the appropriate institutional representatives. They shall remain in force until superseded by official action of either institution.

8.2 Should either or both institutions decide to withdraw from this agreement, it is agreed that any and all students enrolled in this program will be given the opportunity to complete the program of study described in this articulation agreement.
