Official high school transcript with graduation date OR high school equivalency (GED®/HiSET®) scores and official college transcripts, if applicable, from each college attended
Joint Service Transcript (veterans & servicemembers) which can be found at <https://jst.doded.mil/>

Proof of citizenship or lawful presence in the United States (Driver's License)

PLACEMENT TESTING

First-time students who do not present valid ACT or SAT scores or who do not show proficiency in reading, math or English will be placed into the appropriate subject area co-requisite learning support course(s) as defined by the academic program requirements. Valid ACT or SAT scores are those earned within five years prior to the first day of the first term of enrollment.

Students have the option to challenge placement into learning support courses by taking the Accuplacer test.
