Color Contrast Issues with PowerPoint Slides

If you are using PowerPoints with low contrast, it is not a digitally accessible PowerPoint. The majority of the contrast issues are in the bullets. In Ally, it will say the following:

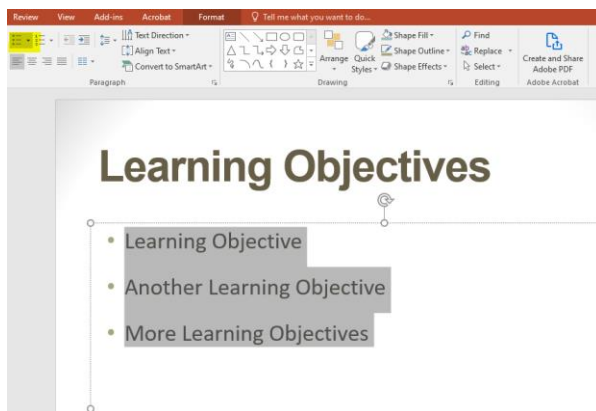
Upload a version with sufficient contrast



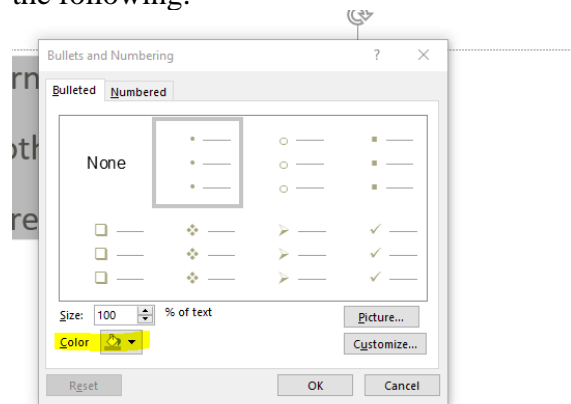
Drop file to upload

To change the color of the bullets, select the content with bullets and go to the Ribbon where the bullet formatting is.



Click on the bullet down arrow and click on Bullets and Numbering. It opens a new window with the following.



Change the color to a color that will give you proper contrast. For example, I am changing the color to black because my slide background is white.
