Here is the digital Accessibility Tip of the Week: Links

When you are including links in your documents, make sure all link text is meaningful and descriptive.

For example, the link above is a link to the Bookings calendar on the digital accessibility website. It looks like this:

When using a screen reader, it would read every letter and dash of the URL so it would make it more difficult to navigate. When you use descriptive text, it makes it easier to navigate.

For students using a screen reader, this would also provide users with the proper context of where clicking the link will take them.
